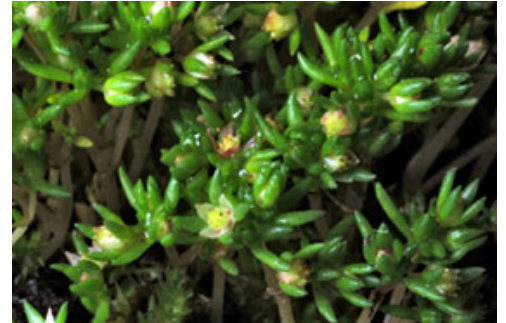
ETYMOLOGY

crassula: From the Latin *crassus* 'thick', meaning 'rather thick'

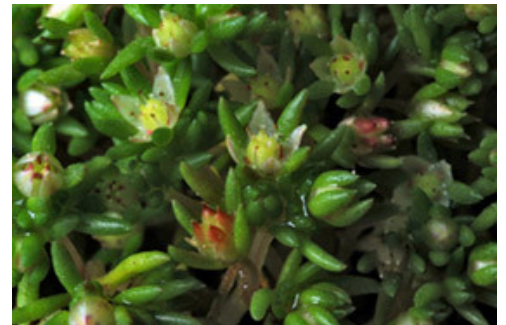
decumbens: From the Latin *decumbere* 'to lie down, recline', in botany refers to creeping plants with upright tips
