Terrace Forest

- # Emergent matai to 20+ m, near Manu Grove;
- # Substantial kohekohe to 20+ m;
- # Abundant seedling kohekohe, sapling karamu
- # Threats include climbing asparagus, Taiwan cherry, puriri saplings and seedlings;

- # Dumping of rubbish,
- # One bait station seen

Swamp Forest

- # Pukatea-dominant, and in places pukatea-swamp maire co- dominant; nikau and kanono common in understorey;
- # Large pukatea common, and seedlings abundant;
- # Abundant kiekie;
- # Numerous swamp maire, to 18m;
- # Kahikatea uncommon: one pole kahikatea seen;
- # Patches of abundant supplejack and wheki;
- # Patches of *Lemna minor*;
- # Clear, slow-flowing water;
- # Native fish habitat?
- # Threats include climbing asparagus, large, introduced lily ca. 1.5m, and on margins, jasmine;
- # One bait station seen.
