



Threatened Plants of New Zealand

Key to the poster

The threatened plants shown on this poster are listed here, along with their threat category and the names of the photographers who kindly provided images.

National Threat Categories

NATIONALLY CRITICAL

Very small population or a very high predicted decline.

NATIONALLY ENDANGERED

Small population and moderate-high recent or predicted decline OR small-moderate population and high recent or predicted decline.

NATIONALLY VULNERABLE

Small-moderate population and moderate recent or predicted decline.

SERIOUS DECLINE

Moderate-large population and moderate-large predicted decline OR small-moderate population and small-moderate predicted decline.

GRADUAL DECLINE

Moderate-large population and small-moderate decline.

SPARSE

If the taxon does not fit the criteria for the acutely or chronically threatened categories and the taxon is naturally or unnaturally rare, with small widely scattered subpopulations.

RANGE RESTRICTED

If the taxon does not fit the criteria for the acutely or chronically threatened categories and the area of occupancy of the taxon is less than 100 km² for terrestrial and freshwater taxa.

on Network


The New Zealand Plant Conservation Network was established in April 2003 and now has more than 230 members throughout New Zealand and the world. The Network was established with the vision that:

no indigenous species of plant will become extinct nor be placed at risk of extinction as a result of human action or indifference, and that the rich, diverse and unique plant life of New Zealand will be recognised, cherished and restored.
